How much does it cost? The Loudoun Farm Tour is free to participate in and you don't need tickets! There are fees at some sites for food, drinks and special activities. Check the icons on each location for more information.

What is happening during Farm Tour? From charming encounters with llamas, alpacas, and donkeys to indulging in delectable homemade ice cream at a dairy farm, the Loudoun Spring Farm Tour offers a cornucopia of experiences for visitors of all ages. Featuring diverse farms showcasing the finest products that Loudoun has to offer, including honey, mushrooms, traditional vegetables, garlic, and craft beverages, attendees will have the opportunity to immerse themselves in the rich tapestry of Loudoun's agricultural heritage.

Will the bird flu affect Farm Tour? The Farm Tour will continue as planned, but you may notice some extra precautions at individual farms, including shoe wash stations and hand sanitizer. Chat with the farmers you visit during the tour to learn more about how they handle adversity on the farm!

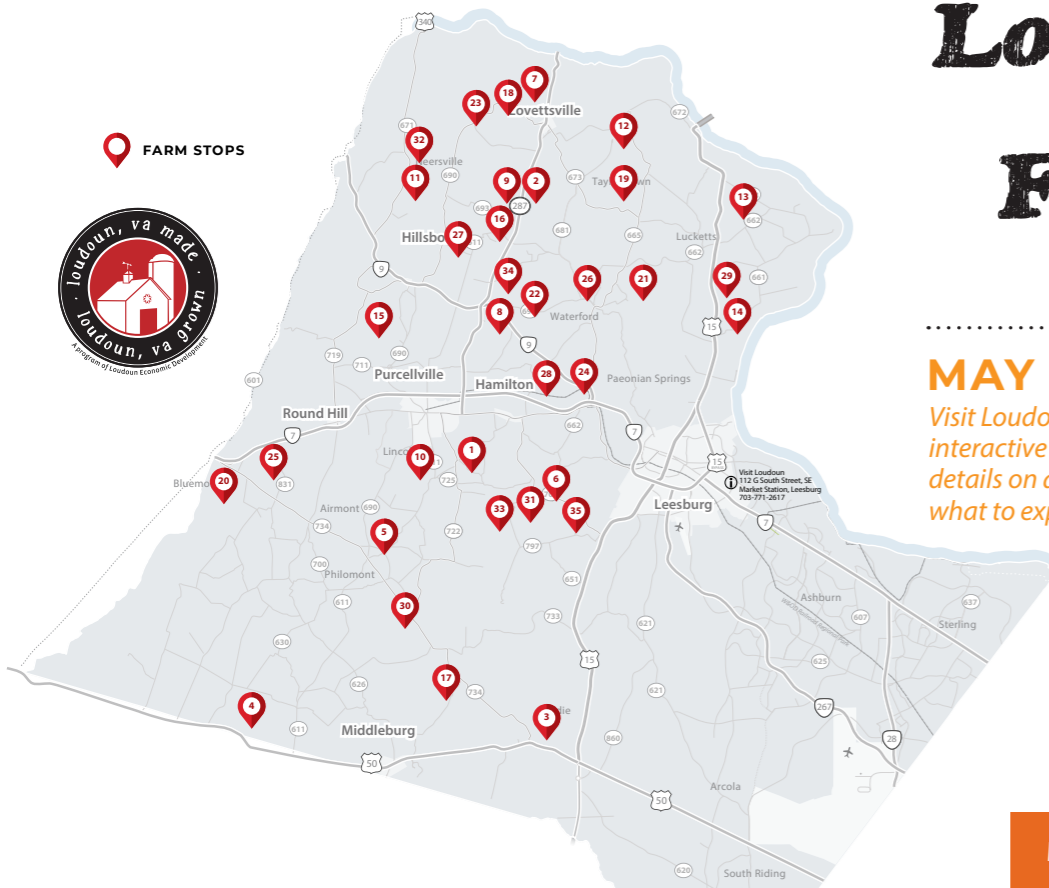
